### My Annotated MARC To Do List:

Complete the task of generating 7 MARCONI Operational Guidelines and sending them to the League. So far, 6 are completed. The 7 program Directors are all helping here (NZ1J, KC1NQE, WB1GYZ, K1RCT, N1ZN, KB1JL, K1LYP)

Start the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase of MARCONI – trying to reinvigorate NARL – the Newington Amateur Radio League. This club needs to grow and become active – like it was many years ago. The idea of a Club Elmering a Club is semi-novel but will take a bunch of work. Lead hams are W1YSM and N1BRL

- Coordinate the effort to Launch a Club Weather balloon (Ray KC1QLS) is taking the lead
- Coordinate the Park & Rec FCC License Course lead is AB1DQ
- Coordinate the Nutmeg Hamfest (N1GNV and WA1TRY)
- Organize Field Day (Captain TBA soon; in Field site KC1NQE)
- Start the Constitution/Bylaws Committee and guide it through its given task
- Consider assisting with Closer to Free Yale Bike Ride for Cancer Care
- Host a SKYWARN Session May 17 at OEM
- Facilitate MARC involvement with Served Agencies YMCA, HITWG, MS Walk, Town of Wallingford – (All coordinated by KB1JL)
- Promote involvement in the BIG E (again) thanks to KC1OYN
- Support CERG/WARG activities (lead by KB1JL)
- Several other seasonal activities: Town Strolls, Town "Tastes",
- CQ Santa, Scholarships, Holiday Party are waiting in the wings.

Yup, it's a lot of things. I am pleased, grateful and proud, that so many Club members are participating in all these efforts. If you ask me what I view my job at MARC is, my answer might surprise you. ### **BUSINESS MEETING MARCH 9, 2023 ZOOM**

Business Meeting March 9, 2023 via Zoom videoconference Meeting was called to order by President Ed Snyder, W1YSM at 19:00 EDT

<u>Announcements</u> (W1YSM), business meetings at 7PM will continue on Zoom at least until spring. Our Special Service Club Status with the ARRL is noted in QST with a letter from Bud Kozloff, W1NSK ARRL CT Section Manager. The radio room is available on Sundays by appointment, contact any officer for details. Wearing of name badges with call signs is encouraged. The Governor proclaimed CT Amateur Radio Recognition Week for April 16 -22.

<u>Secretary's Report</u> (N1BRL), the February Business meeting minutes were approved by a majority vote. Three new members were each approved for membership David Minster NA2AA, David Laliberte KB1TBL, and Joshua Wrinn KC1SLV. There was no correspondence to report.

<u>Treasurer's Report.</u> was read by Rick KC1OYN. The complete Treasure's report included a review of MARC finances, membership dues, the annual audit and review and renewal of Insurance Policies. The complete report is available to members upon request to the Treasurer.

<u>Station Manager's Report</u> (K1RCT), The Station Activity Manager reported increased Saturday morning activities at the OEM. The computers, operating systems and software are all updated. The full Station Activity Managers report is available upon request.

<u>Standing Committees.</u> The activity for March will be Bud Kozloff W1NSK the new ARRL Section Manager. The April activity meeting is expected be a presentation on a balloon launch by Ray KC1QLS The scholarship information has been sent to the local high schools.

<u>Other Activities.</u> A new refresher CW class was suggested in anticipation of Field Day. K1LHO will lead Contest Activations. Suggestions for revisions to the Constitution/Bylaws are due by the end of March. All of the club's on the air nets continue to be active.

<u>Continuing Business</u>, The monthly VE Sessions continue to attract multiple examinees both new and upgrades. WARG/EMCOM has monthly training sessions for CERT which has now combined with the Medical Reserve Corp. The Education Initiative will have classes in the fall in cooperation with the Park & Rec Dept. It is expected to be 8 weeks with a VE Session for the members of the class.

The MARCONI Project with its 7 components is moving forward with most of the documentation completed and ready for submission to the ARRL.

An informal online poll during Zoom was conducted concerning a design for name/call sign badges resulted in a split decision.

Marc's participation in "Closer to Free" will be investigated by W1YSM.

A spring ham flea market event is being considered.

A complete list of this year's activities for MARC was distributed to members via the Reflector.
